RESOLVE, Relating to Fishing in Taylor Pond.

Fishing in Taylor pond regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be and hereby is directed to issue a rule and regulation permitting the catching of white perch in Taylor pond in Auburn from the time the ice goes out until the following September 30th inclusive of each year.
