STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, Relative to White Perch fishing in Lake Anasagunticook.

White perch fishing in Lake Anasagunticook, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game is hereby directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Lake Anasagunticook in the towns of Canton and Hartford in the county of Oxford, to white perch fishing as soon as the ice is out in the spring.
