RESOLVE, Relating to Fishing in Pleasant River and Hapgood Brook.

Fishing in Pleasant river and Hapgood brook, regulated. Resolved:
That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be and hereby is directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Pleasant river and its tributaries in Mason, Bethel and Albany, and Hapgood brook in Bethel, in the county of Oxford to fishing under the general law.
