STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, Relative to Fishing in C. Pond.

Fishing in C. pond, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be and hereby is directed to issue the following rules and regulations on fishing in C. pond situated in township C. Surplus in Oxford county; making a bag limit of not more than 10 fish in all in any one day for any person, party or the occupants of any one boat, canoe, raft or other vessel and prohibiting more than 2 lines to any one boat, canoe, raft or other vessel; and prohibiting the taking of fish less than 10 inches in length and prohibiting the taking or possession of more than 2 fish by any one person in any 1 day from September 1st to September 30th, both days inclusive and prohibiting the transportation on or from said pond of more than 1 day's legal catch of fish.
