# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-FIVE

#### AN ACT Relating to Forcible Entry and Detainer.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 108, § 3, amended.** Section 3 of chapter 108 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 3. Jurisdiction. Trial justices and judges of municipal courts have jurisdiction of cases of forcible entry and detainer respecting estates within their counties. Such justices and judges have exclusive jurisdiction of such cases within their cities or towns, unless interested; provided, however, that judges of municipal courts shall also have jurisdiction of such cases in all towns in which they are authorized to hold court notwithstanding the fact that their residence may be in some other town.'
