RESOLVE, Relating to Smelt Fishing in St. Croix River.

Smelt fishing in St. Croix river, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be and hereby is directed to issue a rule and regulation making it unlawful to take smelts in any of the waters of the St. Croix river above tide-waters for the same period that such waters are closed to all fishing and making it lawful to take smelts with an ordinary hand dip-net from April 15th to May 15th of each year under the general law.
