## AN ACT Relating to Clerk Hire in Penobscot County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 125, § 46, ¶ 11, amended. Paragraph 11 of section 46 of chapter 125 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Penobscot county: for clerks in the office of register of deeds, \$4180; for clerks in the office of register of probate, two thousand dollars \$3300, and this sum shall cover the cost of indexing all documents, papers and records of said office; for clerks in the office of clerk of courts, twenty two hundred fifty dollars \$2288; for clerks in the office of county attorney \$1000. The elerk of the judicial courts in the county of Penobscot, by and with the approval of any justice of the supreme judicial court, may employ, from time to time, such elerks or typists as may be necessary to efficiently earry on the work of his office. The compensation of said elerks or typist to be fixed by said elerk of courts, with the approval of said justice, and paid from the county treasury.'
