**RESOLVE, Relating to Ice Fishing for Perch in Orneville Ponds, or
Boyd Lakes.**

Ice fishing for perch in Orneville ponds, permitted. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation permitting the catching and killing of perch in Orneville ponds (Boyd lakes, so-called) in Piscataquis county during the season that they are open for ice fishing for pickerel.
