STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED

RESOLVE, in Favor of Arthur G. Thombs, of Castine.

Arthur G. Thombs, compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$106 to compensate Arthur G. Thombs of Castine, for damage to his well, caused by the change of grade and location in constructing a third-class highway, said sum to be paid from the general highway funds.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

In constructing a third-class highway, in 1929, in the town of Castine, the grade and location of the improved section of the road was changed, thereby making unusable the well of Arthur G. Thombs, and necessitated his having a new well dug at an expense to him of \$106.

The designation of the road in question was changed in 1932 to that of "state-aid."
