#### RESOLVE, in Favor of William Burgess, of Waterville.

William Burgess; compensation to. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, in favor of William Burgess, of Waterville, the sum of \$148 for payment as inspector in the department of the secretary of state, said sum to be paid from the highway police funds.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Burgess is a state highway police officer. On March 11, 1933 he was assigned to the department of secretary of state on motor vehicle inspection. He continued with the department until April 7, 1933. During this 4 weeks period, he was entitled to pay of \$34.52 per week but has never received it.
