### STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Castine.

Town of Castine; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$450 to be paid to the state aid joint fund of the Town of Castine to reimburse said fund for money taken for payment of a damage claim, said sum to be paid from general highway funds.

### STATEMENT OF FACTS

In the building of a state aid road it was claimed by Mr. Walling that his property was damaged by cutting of grade. The claim was not presented until at least 5 years after the work was done. The state highway commission held a hearing voted \$500 from the joint fund without the town's consent.
