**RESOLVE, Authorizing the Forest Commissioner to Sell Certain Public
Lots in Webster Plantation, in Penobscot County.**

Forest commissioner authorized to sell lots in Webster Plantation. Resolved: That the forest commissioner be, and hereby is, authorized to sell and convey to actual settlers thereon certain lands in Webster plantation, in Penobscot county, constituting part of the school lots of said plantation, if he deems advisable. The said commissioner shall decide the acreage to be sold, the price per acre and the terms of payment; and provided that the proceeds of any sales made shall be added to the school fund of said plantation.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This land is occupied by Alfred Smith and others of Webster plantation. They wish to secure a better title than the squatters' claims or deeds which they now have.
