IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, Authorizing the Forest Commissioner to Convey Certain Land in Drew to Josephine Morse.

Preamble. Whereas, the town of Drew, on July 14, 1924 conveyed to Albert Morse, of Drew in Penobscot county a certain lot, or parcel of land located in said Drew by its warranty deed recorded in the Penobscot registry of deeds, book 973, page 421, and

Whereas, by chapter 49 of the public laws of 1933, the said town of Drew surrendered its organization, and

Whereas, the said lot, or parcel of land was devised to Josephine Morse by the will of the said Albert Morse, now therefore be it

Deed validated. Resolved: That the said warranty deed be, and hereby is, by this resolve declared valid, and further be it

Parcel in Drew to be conveyed. Resolved: That the forest commissioner be, and hereby is, empowered and directed to convey in fee simple to Josephine Morse the title of the state in and to said parcel of land in Drew as bounded and described in Penobscot registry of deeds, book 973, page 421, the same being the same premises conveyed by the town of Drew to Albert Morse, as aforesaid.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

While Drew was an incorporated town this land was sold to the Morse estate and owing to an error the selectmen signed as assessors. They were authorized in the annual town meeting to make this sale by vote of the town. The land was paid for and the money has now been turned back to the state.
