RESOLVE, Authorizing the Sale of State's Interest in Certain Lands.

Sale of certain state lands, authorized. Resolved: That the forest commissioner be, and hereby is, authorized to sell and convey to Zechariah Chafee of Providence, Rhode Island, whatever interest the state may have in the following described property, to wit:

Welch's Island, also sometimes known as Welch's Ledges, situated in the town of Sorrento, county of Hancock, Maine, containing about $\frac{3}{8}$ of an acre and lying about 1000 feet southerly from Ingall's Island, so-called, in said town of Sorrento.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Zechariah Chafee believed that Welch's Island, also sometimes known as Welch's Ledges, containing about $\frac{3}{8}$ of an acre, was always a part of his land, and has been paying taxes to the town of Sorrento on same for the past 20 years.
