RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Canton.

Town of Canton, reimbursed for costs of temporary ferry. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$770.05 to be paid to the town of Canton to reimburse the town for the cost of providing a ferry across the Androscoggin river to accommodate cross-river travel during the demolition of the old bridge and the construction of the new highway bridge across the Androscoggin river, connecting the Gilbertville section of the town of Canton with the Canton Point section of said town, said sum to be paid from the general highway fund.
