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**RESOLVE, in Favor of the Estate of Ella M. Bagley.**

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**Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$818.06 to be paid to the estate of Ella M. Bagley late of Eastport, in the county of Washington, in payment of the dividend due her from the Pittsfield Trust Company; the same to be paid from funds held by the treasurer of state subject to demands of depositors of said Pittsfield Trust Company, said sum to be paid from the receiver's funds held in the state treasury.

### STATEMENT OF FACTS

Pittsfield Trust went into hands of receivers in 1913. Ella Bagley and her husband, A. C. Bagley, had a joint savings account in that bank and when the receivers "settled up" they paid 95% on savings accounts. Bank book shows that Ella and A. C. Bagley had \$843.36 in that bank on December 1912. There now is \$843.59 in hands of state treasurer subject to demands of depositors. There is nothing to show that Ella or A. C. Bagley or heirs have received any dividend.
