STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
THIRTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, in Favor of C. Herbert Perry.

C. Herbert Perry, appropriation for land taken and damage caused by the building of a state bridge. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$100, to be paid to C. Herbert Perry to compensate him for land taken and damage occasioned by building a state bridge at Island Falls in the county of Aroostook over the west branch of the Mattawamkeag river, said sum to be paid from the general highway fund.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

During the season of 1933 the state highway commission built a bridge over the west branch of the Mattawamkeag river in Island Falls. As the bridge was laid out by the commission and the county commissioners they took approximately $\frac{1}{2}$ of a lot owned by said C. Herbert Perry at the southeast side of said bridge; and further by raising the height of the bridge it prevents Perry from reaching the remaining portion of his land without trespassing. It has rendered the lot worthless for any use whatever, and the sum of \$200 would be a reasonable value of said lot before the building of the new bridge.
