STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Norris Wescott, of Prospect.

Norris Wescott; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, the sum of \$600 to be paid to Norris Wescott of Prospect, to compensate him in full for injuries received while working for the state; said sum to be paid from the general highway fund.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Wescott was injured Sept. 18, 1931, while working for the state on the approach to the Waldo-Hancock bridge by being knocked down by an automobile. An agreement was signed allotting Mr. Wescott \$12 per week under the compensation statute which later was reduced to \$8 per week.

The total compensation paid amounted to \$902. The medical expenses Mr. Wescott paid amounted to \$747.75. Mr. Wescott was disabled for 9 months. At that time the settlement did not cover the mental disability of Mr. Wescott. A severe head injury so weakened his mind that he is now partially incompetent.
