STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
THIRTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Lang Plantation.

Lang plantation; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$500 to be paid to Lang plantation to reimburse said plantation for the sum of \$500, which was assessed in error to said plantation by the state of Maine and paid by said plantation to the state of Maine for mothers' aid in favor of one Mae Bachelder, said sum to be paid from the general state funds.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The state of Maine assessed Lang plantation for mothers' aid in favor of Mae Bachelder the sum of \$500, which was paid to the state of Maine by said plantation over a period commencing Sept. 24, 1931, and ending Jan. 16, 1934.

The assessment was made in error and Lang plantation should not have paid said sum. As soon as the error was called to the attention of the department of health and welfare, the assessments ceased.

The following list shows the dates the assessments were made, the amount of each assessment and the date each assessment was paid:

Where the assessment was made in error by the state department, Lang plantation should be reimbursed not only for the \$500 paid, but also for interest thereon amounting to \$73.04 as of July 1, 1935.
