**RESOLVE, Relating to the Dipping of Smelts in Mousam Lake in the
Towns of Acton and Shapleigh.**

Dipping of smelts in Mousam lake, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation opening the tributaries to Mousam lake, in the towns of Acton and Shapleigh, to the dipping of smelts with a daily limit of 2 quarts per person.
