IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Women Prisoners.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. L., 1933, c. 1, additional. Chapter 1 of the public laws of 1933 is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered section 354-A and to read as follows:

'Sec. 354-A. Women prisoners to be sent to women's reformatory. The department may cause quarters to be provided at the reformatory for women for the incarceration of all women now at state's prison and of all women henceforth committed to state's prison. All women now serving sentence in the state's prison may, upon the approval of this act, be transferred to the reformatory for women to serve the remainder of the term of sentence under which said women were committed to the state's prison.'
