STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, for the Purchase of One Hundred Copies of "The First Century of the Town of Naples."

Purchase of books by state; appropriation for. Resolved: That the state purchase 100 copies of the book entitled "The First Century of the Town of Naples," with sketches of the settlement and incorporation of the adjoining towns of Baldwin, Bridgton, Harrison, Otisfield, Raymond and Sebago, of which Naples was formerly a part; arranged and edited, jointly, by Llewellyn Barton and John A. Marshall; said books to be exchanged or distributed at the discretion of the state librarian; and that there be, and hereby is, appropriated for this purpose, the sum of \$500.
