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**STATE OF MAINE**

**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED

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**RESOLVE, in Favor of Richard Clayton French, of Carmel.**

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**Richard Clayton French, compensated. Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, the sum of \$300 to be held in trust by the department of health and welfare, to be expended by it for the benefit of Richard Clayton French, said sum being a settlement in full for injuries inflicted on him by Maurice Eastman, a state charge, said sum to be paid from the general state funds.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS

Maurice Eastman, 15 years of age, state charge, boarding at Gertrude Emery's, Carmel, attending Carmel Village grammar school, kicked Clayton French, son of John French, of Carmel, on his left leg just below the hip, causing severe injury.

He was taken to the Shriners Hospital, Springfield, Mass. in Nov. 1933. His condition was pronounced as osteomyelitis. Clayton was discharged from the Shriners Hospital, December 1933, with abscess still discharging and continued to discharge until the latter part of April, 1934.
