STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, Regulating Ice Fishing in Pleasant, Mud and Horseshoe Ponds, Cobbosseecontee Stream and the Tacoma Chain of Lakes in the Counties of Kennebec and Sagadahoc.

Ice fishing in Pleasant, Mud and Horseshoe ponds, Cobbosseecontee stream and the Tacoma chain of lakes, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Pleasant and Mud ponds in the counties of Kennebec and Sagadahoc, and Horseshoe pond and Cobbosseecontee stream below Horseshoe pond to fishing through the ice under the general law and the Tacoma chain of lakes in Kennebec county to fishing through the ice for white perch and pickerel only on Thursdays and Saturdays of each week from February 1st to March 15th.
