IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Tributaries to Pleasant Pond in Kennebec and Sagadahoc Counties.

Fishing in tributaries to Pleasant pond, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation opening the tributaries to Pleasant and Mud ponds and Cobbosseecontee stream below Horseshoe pond in the counties of Kennebec and Sagadahoc to ice fishing under the general law.
