AN ACT Relating to Facsimile Signature of Clerks of Courts.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. Facsimile signatures of clerks of courts provided for. A facsimile of the signature of the clerks of the supreme judicial and superior courts, and of the judge or recorder of municipal courts, imprinted by or at his direction upon any writ, or summons, shall have the same validity as his written signature.

Sec. 2. Repealing clause. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent with this provision are hereby repealed.
