STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Bessie M. Dunton, of Moscow.

Bessie M. Dunton; compensated for time in quarantine. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, the sum of \$1000, to be paid to Bessie M. Dunton, of Moscow, for the time she was in quarantine by order of the department of health and welfare, as a typhoid carrier, said sum to be paid from the general state funds; and be it further

Resolved, that Bessie M. Dunton, shall receive \$7 per week from the appropriation for, "Aid to Typhoid Carriers," for such period as she shall be classified by the bureau as a typhoid carrier.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This woman was found to be a typhoid carrier and was quarantined by the proper state authorities during which time she was unable to carry on her usual occupation of marketing produce.
