IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Certain World War Veterans.

Claims, appropriation in payment of. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated to be paid to each person hereinafter named, the sums set opposite their respective names, amounting in the aggregate to the sum of \$500, as a bonus for World War service, as provided by section 1 of chapter 160 of the revised statutes; said sum to be paid from the general state funds.
