## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Clerk Hire in the Office of Register of Deeds for the Southern District of Aroostook County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 125, § 46, ¶ 3, amended. So much of the 2nd and 3rd lines of the 3rd paragraph of section 46 of chapter 125 of the revised statutes as relates to clerk hire in the office of register of deeds for the southern district of Aroostook county, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'for clerks in the office of register of deeds for the southern district, twenty nine hundred dollars \$3200;
