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**RESOLVE, Appropriating Money to Pay the Claim of Frank D. and Evelyn C. Goodwin, of Hermon, Against the State of Maine.**

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**Frank D. and Evelyn C. Goodwin; compensated for a claim against the state. Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, the sum of \$1700 as a full and final settlement to Frank D. and Evelyn C. Goodwin, of Hermon, of all claims against the state of Maine for the loss of buildings, furniture and personal property, etc., caused by a fire set by Philip Henry, a state ward, said sum to be paid from the general state funds.

### STATEMENT OF FACTS

This fire occurred on October 30, 1932. Philip Henry, age 13, a state ward, confessed to setting the fire in the hay mow.
