**AN ACT Providing for the Manufacture of Motor Vehicle Registration
Plates for the Use of the State at the State Prison.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. Motor vehicle plates to be manufactured at state prison. The secretary of state or the duly designated official in charge of motor vehicle registration shall, when this act becomes law, purchase and cause to be installed at the state prison the necessary equipment and materials for the production of all motor vehicle registration plates used in the state; and thereafter no such plates shall be purchased for state use except such as cannot be produced at the prison.

Sec. 2. Warden of the prison to have charge of production; may employ temporary supervisor. The warden of the state prison shall have charge of operations at the state prison relative to the manufacture of all plates made for the state. He may, with the consent of the secretary of state employ for limited periods of time a supervisor for the purpose of instructing inmates in the operation of making such plates.

Sec. 3. Appropriation. For the purpose of carrying out the provisions

of this act, the secretary of state may expend such sum not to exceed \$8000 as in his judgment may be necessary, and said funds are hereby appropriated, from the general highway fund.
