**RESOLVE, Relating to Fishing in B Pond.**

---

**Fishing in B pond, regulated. Resolved:** That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation that trolling shall be lawful in the waters of B pond in the town of Upton in the county of Oxford, during the open season provided by the general law; provided further, that it shall be unlawful for any 1 person to take, catch and kill in any 1 day more than 5 pounds of trout and salmon unless the last fish caught may increase the weight of the catch to more than 5 pounds.
