IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, Relating to Fishing in B Pond.

Fishing in B pond, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation that trolling shall be lawful in the waters of B pond in the town of . Upton in the county of Oxford, during the open season provided by the general law; provided further, that it shall be unlawful for any I person to take, catch and kill in any I day more than 5 pounds of trout and salmon unless the last fish caught may increase the weight of the catch to more than 5 pounds.
