#### STATE OF MAINE

### AN ACT Relating to Indians.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. R. S., c. 17, additional. Chapter 17 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered section 58-A, and to read as follows:
- 'Sec. 58-A. Indians to have free hunting and fishing. All Indians of both the Passamaquoddy and Penobscot tribes in the state upon presentation of their certificate of registration shall be issued a hunting and fishing license without charge.'
- Sec. 2. Inconsistent acts repealed. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this act are hereby repealed.
