IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Tenure of Office of Town Manager of Fort Fairfield.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Tenure of office of town manager of Fort Fairfield. Section 8 of chapter 65 of the private and special laws of 1929 is hereby amended by striking out all of said section and inserting the following in place thereof:

'Sec. 8. Tenure of office. All appointed officers and voters shall hold office at the pleasure of the appointing power, except those of town manager and health officer. The town manager can only be removed upon written charges preferred by the selectmen, and by a majority vote of the legally qualified voters of the town present and voting at a regular or special town meeting called for that purpose after a public hearing. The health officer can only be removed upon written charges and public hearing before the selectmen.'
