**RESOLVE to Regulate Fishing in Sebago Lake in the County of
Cumberland.**

Resolved: Fishing in Sebago Lake, regulated. That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game is hereby directed to issue a rule and regulation establishing a daily bag limit on fish taken from Sebago Lake, in the county of Cumberland, at not more than 3 in the aggregate of salmon, trout, bass or white fish per person per day.
