AN ACT Relating to Licenses to Operate Motor Vehicles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. L. 1935, c. 139, amended. Chapter 139 of the public laws of 1935, designated as section 33-A of chapter 29 of the revised statutes, is hereby repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

'Sec. 33-A. Operators' licenses issued only when poll taxes have been paid. No license shall be issued to any person who is a resident of this state and subject to a poll tax therein, until he has paid all poll taxes legally assessed against him to the city, town or subdivision thereof wherein he resides.

Receipts for the payment of such tax shall be in the form prescribed by the secretary of state. They shall be issued in duplicate, and 1 copy shall be delivered to the secretary of state at the time application is made to operate a motor vehicle, and filed with the application.'
