## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Reports to Towns of Excise Tax Payments.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- P. L., 1933, c. 166, amended. Chapter 166 of the public laws of 1933 is hereby repealed and the following is hereby enacted as section 100 of chapter 12 of the revised statutes:
- 'R. S., c. 12, § 100. Report of excise tax payments. The state auditor shall report annually, before June 30th of each year, to each town and city in the state, showing the amount of excise tax payments on automobiles paid to that town or city for the registration year previous, according to the receipts which have been filed with the secretary of state.'
