**AN ACT to Increase the Amount to be Paid for Clerk Hire in the Office of
Register of Deeds, in the County of Penobscot.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 125, § 46, amended. The 1st and 2nd lines in paragraph 11 of section 46 of chapter 125 of revised statutes are hereby amended so that they in so far as they relate to the annual amount to be paid for clerks in the office of register of deeds in Penobscot county shall read as follows:

'Penobscot county: for clerks in the office of register of deeds, ~~forty one hundred eighty dollars~~ \$5220;'
