RESOLVE, Relative to Fishing in Clemons Ponds.

Fishing in Clemons Ponds, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game, be and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation, closing to all fishing the tributaries of both the Clemons Ponds, in the town of Hiram, county of Oxford.
