AN ACT Relating to Foxes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 38, § 75, amended. Section 75 of chapter 38 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 75. Digging out foxes forbidden. No person shall at any time dig out, molest or destroy in any way any fox **or raccoon den, den tree** or hole, or set any trap in any such den, **den tree** or hole, or remove or cause to be removed from any such den, **den tree** or hole, any fox **or raccoon** except those enclosed in private fox **or raccoon** ranches.'
