RESOLVE, Relating to Lobster Fishing in Winter Harbor.

Lobster fishing in Winter Harbor, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of sea and shore fisheries be, and hereby is, directed to repeal rule and regulation numbered 5, relating to catching of lobsters.
