**RESOLVE, in Favor of a Rebate of Certain Taxes for the Town of
Lincolnvile.**

Rebate of Certain Taxes for the Town of Lincolnvile. Resolved: That the state tax assessor shall from time to time when the state tax is due from the town of Lincolnvile compute the proportionate value of the taxable property of the town of Lincolnvile that became exempt from taxation because of the creation of the state or national park therein and rebate to the said town of Lincolnvile the amount which the said town lost in taxes for that assessment year because of the creation of said park.
