STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
THIRTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Provide for Issuing Duplicate Hunting and Fishing Licenses.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 38, § 19, amended. Section 19 of chapter 38 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended by adding thereto a new paragraph to be numbered (2a), and to read as follows:

‘(2a) The commissioner of inland fisheries and game, or his authorized agent, shall issue a duplicate license for fishing to any person who has accidentally lost or had destroyed his fishing license, upon payment by said person to the commissioner of inland fisheries and game or his authorized agent, the sum of 25c for such duplicate license.’

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 38, § 41, amended. Section 41 of chapter 38 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended by adding thereto a new paragraph to be numbered 6-B, and to read as follows:

‘6-B. The commissioner of inland fisheries and game, or his authorized agent, shall issue a duplicate license for hunting to any person who has accidentally lost or had destroyed his fishing license, upon payment by said person to the commissioner of inland fisheries and game or his authorized agent, the sum of 25c for such duplicate license.’
