STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
THIRTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Fishing and Hunting Licenses.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. Poll tax receipt required for issuance of fishing license. Section 19 of chapter 38 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended by adding at the end of said section the following words:

‘No resident of the state of Maine shall be issued a fishing license unless he presents to the proper officer a receipt for his poll tax up to date. The respective city or town treasurers shall issue such receipt to each tax payer paying his poll tax on request for such receipt.’

Sec. 2. Poll tax receipt required for issuance of hunting license. Sub-division numbered 2 of section 41 of chapter 38 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended by adding at the end of said sub-division 2 the following words:

‘No resident of the state of Maine shall be issued a hunting license unless he presents to the proper officer a receipt for his poll tax up to date. The respective city or town treasurers shall issue such receipt to each tax payer paying his poll tax on request for such receipt.’
