RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Flanders Bay.

Fishing in Flanders bay, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of sea and shore fisheries be, and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation prohibiting persons from fishing except by hook and line in Flanders bay inside a line from Doane's Point, so-called, in Sorrento, to Taft's Point, so-called, in Gouldsboro.

Whoever shall violate the provisions hereof shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$50 for each offense.
