**RESOLVE, Granting Authority to the Forestry Department to Sell
Certain Land.**

Forestry department authorized to sell certain land. Resolved: That the forest commissioner be, and hereby is, authorized to sell the following described lot to the Federal Land Bank of Springfield, Massachusetts for the sum of \$78.42:

Lot 2 of 52 acres in Township 15, Range 6, W. E. L. S., Aroostook county. 20 acres of 100 acres in lot 23 in Township 15, Range 6, W. E. L. S., Aroostook county. 20 acres of 98 acres in lot 24 in Township 15, Range 6, W. E. L. S., Aroostook county.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This property, reputed to be owned by Maxine Gagnon, of Winterville, was acquired by the forest commissioner in behalf of the state in 1934 for non-payment of 1932 taxes. The Federal Land Bank of Springfield, Massachusetts holding a mortgage on same desire to take it over by paying the taxes in arrears which figured to February 1, 1937 with interest and advertising \$78.42. Check for this amount is now in the hands of the state tax assessor.
