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**AN ACT Providing Aid for School Consolidation.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**Provision for aid in construction of consolidated schools and state supervision of same.** There shall be paid to any city, town, or plantation in which a new school building has been erected, the plans and location of which have been approved by the commissioner of education, the sum of \$1,000 for each classroom displaced in 1, 2, 3, or 4 teacher schools. This amount shall be allotted from appropriations made therefor by the legislature, and shall be paid in the same manner as other state aid is paid and at the time of the next annual allotment of aid following the opening of school in the new building and the abandonment of the small schools. For the purposes of this act there shall be appropriated from the state school fund an amount not exceeding \$25,000 in any one year.
