STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Mount Desert Bridge.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. Cost of lights on Mount Desert bridge to be paid by the state. The maintenance of the lights on Mount Desert bridge, so-called, shall be under the direction of the state, and shall be paid for by the state.
- Sec. 2. Repealing clause. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
