STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
THIRTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Registration of Motor Vehicles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. Registration fees of pleasure cars. All owners of motor vehicles used for pleasure, or, for pleasure and business shall pay a fee for the registration of such cars of \$5 per car.

Sec. 2. Repealing clause. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed or amended to conform with the provisions of section 1 hereof.
